The JMU Enactus team is collecting shoes to help raise money for Women who have been shunned from their villages in Kenya due to having HIV and AIDS. We can use both Men's and Women's shoes of any size. The deadline for shoe donations is April 22nd. The shoes will be sold to a distributor in Kenya which will benefit women in Kiserian-Kenya. The proceeds will buy land and build communities for women that are shunned from their villages when they are diagnosed with these diseases. Our goal is to help fill a shipping container! Shoes must be closed toed, wearable (no holes), and be relatively clean (no obvious dirt). We will be working with an organization called Well of Hope.
